## Important to All Socialists! Purchase Convention Stamps

The National Office has issued special convention stamps, to be sold to members at 50 cents each, to defray the expenses of the National Emergency Convention. No member has a right to refrain from buying at least one stamp. Outside organizations, falsely assuming the name of Socialist Party, are selling stamps of their own, and at the same time trying in every way to starve the National Office by withholding its necessary funds.

No matter what position a member takes on party members, it is the height of disloyalty for him to fail to support the regularly called convention by refraining from giving it the necessary funds. Only by meeting mind to mind can an honest opinion be [hashed?] out. To hamstring the convention by refusing it funds is to add to the party confusion, and to display utter insincerity in the bargain. Branch secretaries are urged to see to it that every member has at least one stamp pasted in his red book.

Be sure that the stamps you buy are from the office of the National Secretary, Adolph Germer, and not from self-appointed custodians of the party's welfare.
